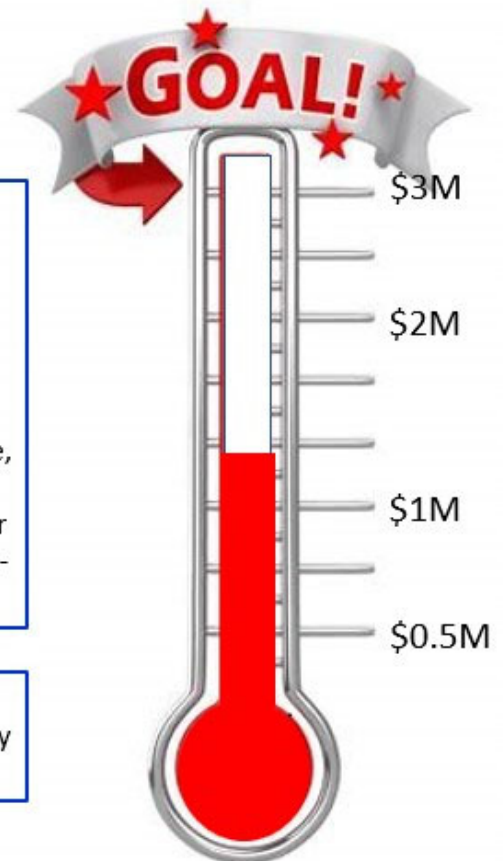

Holy Spirit offers *Adaptive: Finding God* for students of all ages with special needs who desire to prepare for the sacraments and/or enrich their Catholic Faith. This program is free and has a separate registration form.

Weekly Faith Formation (Pre-K - Confirmation)

Classes will be offered on a weekly basis on

- ♦Sunday mornings: 8:30-10:45 (includes Mass)
- ♦Wednesday evenings: 5:45-7:30 (includes Mass)
- ♦Registration is required.
- ♦Fee:
 - ◇K-5: \$60/child for Elementary students
 - ◇ 6th grade and older (Confirmation Preparation students): \$85 each which includes Youth Ministry Fee.
- ♦Adult Catechists who teach weekly will be given a 50% discount .
- ♦Please contact Faye Nye if you are in need of a partial or full scholarship.

Family Catechesis (K-8th grade)

Holy Spirit will be offering *A Family of Faith* Family Catechesis Program for families who prefer to teach their children about the faith at home instead of attending weekly classes.

Lessons are prewritten for parents using a parent friendly Guide and ONE Children's Activity book for all grades Kindergarten through 8th grade! Bilingual books can be provided upon request.

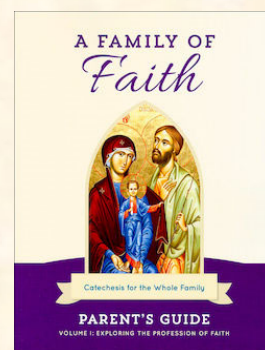
Families would come together two times per month to grow in relationship with one another and learn the truths of the Catholic Faith.

Family Catechesis will meet on Wed. nights from 5:45-7:00 pm two times/month.

This program has a separate registration form.

Fee is \$85/family

**Students in 2nd grade and Confirmation Preparation will still need to attend parent meetings, sacramental retreats and other sacrament preparation events.*



FAITH FORMATION & YOUTH MINISTRY

Confirmation Preparation —(6th grade and older)

Confirmation Preparation is a three year journey traditionally starting in 6th grade.

The **Period of the Catechumenate** occurs in Years 1 and 2 of preparation with **Liturgical Preparation and Discernment** in Year 3.



Confirmation Years 1 and 2 (traditionally grades 6 and 7) will meet onsite weekly on Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings. Catechumenates will be provided opportunities to review Church Doctrine and Teachings, turn to God in prayer and participate in MS Youth Ministry events throughout the year.

Confirmation Year 3: Candidates will meet onsite weekly on Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings for Ministry events which will include spiritual and Liturgical Preparation and Discernment for the Sacrament.

Registration is required (use the Faith Formation/Youth Ministry Form).

High School Youth Ministry

On Sunday nights from 6:00-8:00 p.m. Teens come together for faith, food, fun and fellowship. Weekly attendance is not required; come when you can!

Catholic School Students

2nd grade Catholic School students receive their Faith Formation at Catholic School. However, ministry, service and other components will need to be completed here at their home parish. Registration is required using the Faith Formation/Youth Ministry Form.

6th grade and older Catholic School students who wish to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation will need to register as Catholic School Confirmation Year 1,2 or 3.

Confirmation Years 1 & 2 Catholic School students do not need to attend Church Doctrine and Teaching Sessions but are required as Catechumenates, to participate in all the other Confirmation Preparation components.

Year 3 Catholic School students (Candidates) are required to complete all Liturgical Preparation and Discernment at their home parish which includes but is not limited to Church Doctrine and Teaching Sessions.

Registration is required (use the Faith Formation/Youth Ministry Form).

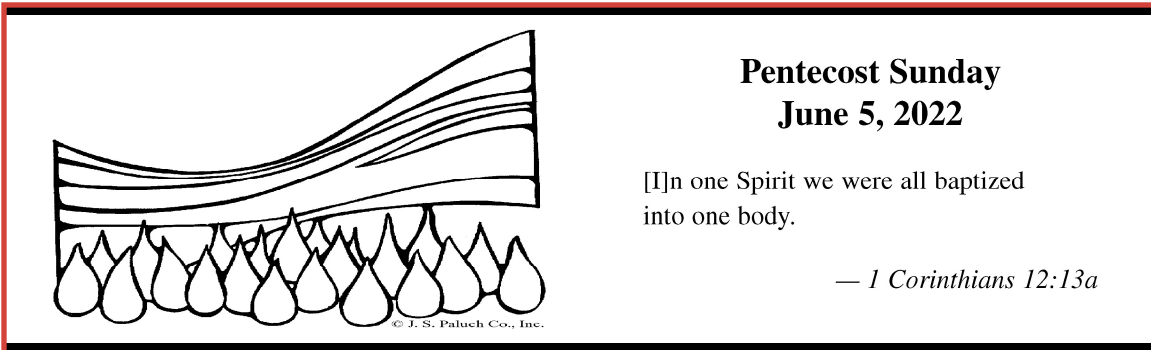

[I]n one Spirit we were all baptized into one body.

— 1 Corinthians 12:13a

PENTECOST SUNDAY

In today's Gospel Luke, the author of Acts, links the "time of Pentecost" to the Jewish Feast of Weeks. This was a harvest festival, fifty days after Passover. The feast became a celebration of God's gift of the Torah, the law of Moses, remembering Exodus 19. Luke suggests that just as the Feast of Weeks was a culmination of Passover, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit was a culmination of the Resurrection. In both Passover and Easter, God's extraordinary saving action rescued God's people from oppression and death. Because of these actions, the stage was set for the gift of Torah, and similarly for Christians, the gift of the Spirit. The ongoing presence of the Spirit sustains us to face life's burdens gracefully. The Spirit also challenges us daily to mature in our capacity to love, and to take part in God's ongoing work to rescue all God's people.

THE SPIRIT'S ACTIVE POWER

The mystery of the Trinity refers to one God in three persons. We frequently acknowledge Jesus as "the second person of the Trinity," but referring also to the Spirit as a "person" comes less naturally. In religious art, the Holy Spirit often appears as a dove or, as in today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, tongues of fire. Much rarer are images of the Spirit as a "person" in recognizable human form. Today's readings do not settle the issue of how to picture the Spirit, but they certainly give shape to the Spirit's active power in the world and in each human heart. In Acts, the Spirit enables people to speak and understand a variety of languages. Paul's letter to the Corinthians praises the Spirit for all kinds of spiritual gifts, services, and "workings." Finally, in John's Gospel, Jesus calls the Spirit our Advocate and our divine teacher.

First Reading — Before anything was created, the wisdom of God was brought forth.
(Proverbs 8:22-31)

Psalm — O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!

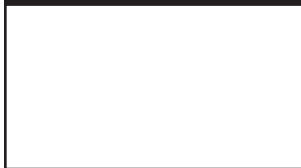
